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Kashmir's culture is a blend of Indian and Central Asian influences. Colorful Pherans (traditional cloaks), handwoven carpets, and renowned pashmina shawls showcase centuries of artistry. Visitors are greeted with

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open arms-Kashmir's hospitality is unrivaled. Attend a local festival or share Kahwa (saffron-infused tea) in a family home for memories you'll cherish.

-> Adventure Awaits

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Love adventure? Try trekking, camping, and mountaineering on the Great Lakes Trek-see Zojilla Zeropoint and the alpine lakes of Vishansar, Krishansar, and Gangbal. In winter, ski the pristine slopes of Gulmarg.

-> Culinary Heaven

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Foodies rejoice! Kashmiri Wazwan is an unforgettable culinary ritual: Rogan Josh, Yakhni, Dum Aloo, and Gushtaba-all best savored with Kahwa. Don't leave without tasting local bread and saffron-scented desserts!

-> When to Visit Kashmir?

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Spring (Mar-May): Blossom season; Tulip festival; mild weather.

Summer (Jun-Aug): Cool and green; best for treks, outdoor adventures.

Autumn (Sep-Nov): Golden chinar trees; apple orchards; fewer crowds.

Winter (Dec-Feb): Magical snowfall in Gulmarg, Pahalgam; perfect for skiing & houseboats.

For the best of all experiences: Time your visit for late March (Tulip season in Srinagar) or December (for snow sports in Gulmarg).
